The Podcast Studio Prompt Pack

A weekly podcast with no microphone, no editing skills, and no studio. This chain takes you from topic to published episode: premise, script, hook, notes, and the repurposing pass that pays for the whole thing.

1 · The Episode Premise

My podcast is about [topic] for [audience].
Here are 5 rough episode ideas: [list].
For each: sharpen it into a premise with a specific promise ("by the end you will know X"), a reason it matters THIS month, and the one story or example that would carry it.
Rank them by how likely a stranger is to press play, and tell me why the winner wins.

2 · The Spoken Script

The step everyone skips. Written English read aloud sounds like a blog post being read aloud.

Write a [10-15] minute podcast script on: [premise from step 1].
Rules: contractions everywhere, sentences under 20 words, spoken transitions ("here is the thing"), one rhetorical question per section, no lists read aloud, facts woven into stories.
Structure: cold open hook (30 seconds), the promise, 3 sections that each land one idea, a single takeaway close.
Write it to be READ ALOUD, not read.

3 · The Cold Open

The first 30 seconds decide whether they stay. Generate options.

Here is my episode script: [paste].
Write 5 cold opens, 30 seconds each, in 5 styles: a surprising number, a story mid-action, a contrarian claim, a listener question, a confession.
Each must create a question the episode answers. Mark the one you would ship and say why in one line.

4 · The Show Notes Machine

From this script: [paste].

Produce: 3 title options under 60 characters (curiosity first, keyword second), a 150-word episode description with the promise up front, 5 timestamped chapter markers, and 3 pull quotes for social.

No hype words: ultimate, insane, game-changing are banned.

5 · The Repurposer

One episode should feed a week of content.

From this episode script: [paste].

Extract: 3 short-form video scripts (30-45 seconds each, hook first), 2 platform posts that stand alone without the episode, 1 newsletter section (150 words), and 1 audiogram moment (the 20 most quotable seconds, quoted exactly).

Everything must make sense to someone who never heard the episode.

TIP, In ElevenLabs, generate section by section, stability 45-55. Regenerating one flat section beats regenerating fifteen minutes.
